To create a more visually pleasing environment and expand the opportunities for residents and visitors to experience quality works of art in public places. In 2003, Avenues of Art was implemented by the Mayor's Art Council to exhibit artwork on Gillette's main streets around the community.

GUIDELINES

- Artist is limited to two (2) entries each year
- Complete Entry Form & sign Exhibit Contract by February 1, 2019. Artists may also submit online at www.mayorsartcouncil.com
- Submit Digital Images Only of Each Entry
 - 8x10, 300dpi resolution
 - plain background preferred
- Artwork submitted must not be less than 48" in height
- Artwork submitted must not be fragile (e.g., limestone), dangerous or inappropriate

IF SELECTED

- Artwork is on display for one (1) year
- Artwork is on sale to the public
 - MAC receives 25% of sale
 - MAC retains additional \$165 of sale for bronze plaque & advertising expenses
- Artists receive a \$1,000 stipend
- Artwork unveiled at the Donkey Creek Festival on Friday, June 21, 2019

This is an agreement between the Mayor's Art Council, the City of Gillette and _____ (artist) concerning display of artwork(s) during the 2019 exhibit.

Artist agrees:

- Artwork(s) submitted is the artist's original and is available for purchase
- Artwork(s) submitted is soundly and professionally constructed of durable and sturdy materials, has no breakable or easily damaged parts or pieces, is suitable for outdoor public display, is constructed in a way which will not cause safety or liability problems, and will require no maintenance during the twelve-month exhibit period
- Artist will be responsible for securely attaching works to a durable steel base or mounting plate in order for the project to be welded or bolted to a metal pedestal or a concrete slab
- Artwork(s) will be delivered by 12:00 p.m. on Friday, June 21, 2019, to Gillette College Technical Education Center, 3251 S. 4-J Road, Gillette, Wyoming 82718
 - If Artwork is not delivered by this day and time, Artist will forfeit the \$1,000 stipend
 - Artwork delivered before Friday, June 21, 2019, will still be displayed in the Community
- All works are committed to the Mayor's Art Council and the City of Gillette for the duration of the exhibit (approximately one year)

Mayor's Art Council and the City of Gillette agrees:

- Mayor's Art Council / City of Gillette will be responsible for securely installing all artwork
- Maintaining catastrophic insurance on all artwork in the event of vandalism, theft, or damage
- Reserve the right to make all installation/placement decisions and to make emergency repairs to artwork (sculptures only, bases not included) when necessary
- Retain a 25% commission and \$165 plaque fee for any artwork purchased during the exhibit period or as a direct result of this exhibit
